

Hello LTPA Members,

The Board is pleased to announce the new method for reserving a storage location for small watercraft (kayak, canoe, or paddleboard) for 2024. As posted on the website, the season will begin on May 1st with the website/portal enabling a member to reserve and pay for watercraft storage.

The process should take a few minutes:

1. Sign into the portal and you will see your information (please update as necessary), along with an area for watercraft storage and picnic table reservations.
2. Enter the watercraft storage area and indicate if you want 1 or 2 storage areas. We have 216 kayak storage spaces and, once they are full, the site will show that all spaces are taken.
3. The system will move to a payment section where you can pay online via credit card or checking account. Once you have completed payment, you will move on to the selection of a storage space(s).
4. You will see a map that resembles our kayak, canoe, and paddleboard storage areas. Based on availability, those areas that are available will show with no color overlay. Those areas that are sold out will have a gray overlay.
5. Pick an available area and you will see a detailed mock-up showing all spaces. Those that are available will not have a color overlay, whereas those which are taken will have a gray overlay. Select your space(s) (depending on how many you have paid for) and they will show with a blue overlay.
6. Exit back to your Dashboard and you will see confirmation of the selected space(s) for this season.

Please note this is a new system for choosing and paying for storage, but all policies remain in place for use of watercraft at our Park.

This method of payment will be available for other chargeable services going forward, including our annual assessments next year. We hope that you find this process convenient and efficient.

We also want to thank those who submitted responses to our forum on fire insurance. They are being used at our next Board meeting and at our Annual Members Meeting in July.
